Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Program: Join the Knights of Columbus Council 4434 on Jul 23 at 4:50 pm (prior to 5:30 Mass) for prayer and spiritual renewal centered on the rosary. The program consists of six silver roses traveling the western, central and eastern corridors of North America, with Knights of Columbus from Canada to Mexico carrying the roses from destination to destination, and finally to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico. This is a part of the Culture of Life program, expanding on the One Rose/One Life program in January.
